

## **APPLICATION FORM FOR COURSE SUBSIDY**

### **Creation, Christian Faith and a Precious World (A Rocha/Faraday Institute)**

**25 June – 1 July, 2017**

A limited number of €200 subsidies are available to enable individuals with financial limitations to participate in this courses run by A Rocha France at Les Courmettes. Successful applicants will have their course charges reduced by this amount.

#### **Are you eligible?**

Three conditions are attached to a subsidy

1. You must be in genuine financial need and unable to attend such a course unless supported by a subsidy.
2. If you are awarded a subsidy then on your return to your home country you must submit a report of between 500 and 1000 words to A Rocha France (either in English or French) covering a) what you have learnt and b) how this will be of value to you. Subject to mutual agreement this report may be subsequently used by A Rocha France for publicity or advertising.
3. As a recipient of a subsidy it is expected that you will a report or give a presentation within your own community, church or culture that explains what you have learnt and how this is of value to you.

#### **How to apply**

Since these subsidies are awarded by open competition, we need sufficient information to allow us to fairly assess applications. Your application for a subsidy must be received by the course organisers *at least 2 months* prior to the starting date of the relevant course: in this case 25 April 2017.

To apply for a subsidy you need to take TWO steps:

Decisions about subsidies will be made very soon after the dead-line for applications in this case by the end of April 2017. Neither A Rocha France nor the Faraday Institute will engage in any discussion or correspondence about why many application for subsidy has been unsuccessful.
