We are looking for volunteers from April to September to help us carry out our conservation activities, including monitoring surveys, on the Courmettes estate managed by A Rocha France – www.courmettes.com.

We plan to relaunch / set up various monitoring surveys:

- Butterflies (daytime)
- Reptiles
- Ocellated lizard
- Hermann's Turtle
- Orsini's Viper
- Pond area (amphibians, odonates – dragonflies and damselflies, flora, orthopterans – grasshoppers, crickets, etc.)
- Other surveys can be envisaged according to your skills (ornithology, botany – including orchids, etc.).

If you share [A Rocha's mission](#) and have one or more naturalist skills in one of these taxa, come and join us!

Like any volunteer and permanent member of the association, we will also ask you to take part in the life of the centre, especially in welcoming groups.

Some important information:

- Duration: minimum 2–3 weeks and up to several months!
- Possibility of accommodation on site (depending on availability: room or tent)
- Cost of accommodation and food (full board): 15€ / day (room); 10€ / day (tent)
